

When Allison's marriage fell apart, she fell into despair and began numbing her pain with alcohol. "I was all alone and gave in to it, and my drinking escalated," she says.

For eight years, she struggled with addiction. Then, one day, she suddenly found herself with a little girl to care for. She'd been given custody of her granddaughter. "I reigned in my drinking and made her my focal point. I loved her dearly."

For more than three years, Allison devoted herself to her granddaughter's happiness. Then her nephew asked to adopt the child and Allison agreed. "It was the best thing for her to be with a family – a mom, a dad, and brothers. But it was terribly hard to let her go."

Allison was alone and heartbroken and she began numbing her sadness again. Then, one night, she awakened to God's voice. "He said, 'You're at the end of the line. You've got to stop doing this.""

It was the catalyst Allison needed to reach out for help. She entered our New Life Program, where chapel services and faith-based studies led her to recommit her life to God. "Now I don't have to be afraid or worried. I just trust God and do my part," she says.

Our biblical counselors and life skills classes have helped Allison find healing for her emotional wounds. "I've forgiven and received forgiveness and I can move on."

Now a program graduate, Allison plans to get her own place and spend her days working with cognitively- and physically-challenged young adults. But more than anything, she's looking forward to spending time with her family. "Because of the Mission, I get to be there for my kids and all my grandchildren."

Expanding Hope, Rebuilding Lives

In the face of unprecedented need, God laid on our hearts a vision for a facility where we could meet physical needs and bring

lasting change to the ever-growing number of people who are hurting, impoverished, and homeless in Coastal Connecticut.

That vision became a reality with the opening of our state-of-the-art **Community Care Center**! This life-changing facility, located at 725 Park Avenue in Bridgeport, provides:

- **Community day services**, where those struggling with poverty and homelessness can access showers, laundry services, medical care, and more.
- A **restaurant-style kitchen** (triple the size of our former kitchen) and a **community cafe**, providing three meals a day, 365 days a year to the community and program residents.
- A Community pantry, dedicated to fresh and wholesome groceries the first of its kind in Bridgeport.
- **Life Change programs**, where spiritual guidance, counseling, and life-skills and job-readiness classes help men and women overcome addiction, and families find healing and self-reliance.

Our new Community Care Center provides an extraordinary opportunity for you to touch and change many more hurting lives in the days to come. And Dan Rogers, our new President and CEO, has the heart, experience, and vision to lead us in this new season.

"I was born in poverty and raised in a crime-stricken community, so I understand the struggles our men and women face every day. But, along the way, great men and women mentored me and, ultimately, opened my heart to a relationship with Jesus Christ...
